A recent study found the average golfer walks about 900 miles a year.

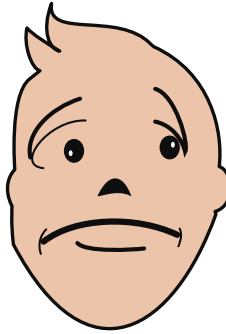
Another study found golfers drink, on average, 22 gallons of beer a year.

# Who invented the helicopter?

There are many people credited with inventing this machine and depending how you look at it, the first practical version is credited to Igor Sikorsky in 1939; even though the first recorded sketches were by Leonardo De Vinci in the 15th century.
