slightest air movement, creating a possible strangling hazard for ornaments hung at neck level.

Storing of ornaments. At the end of the holiday season, carefully remove ornaments from tree, wearing latex gloves to protect ornaments from oils in your skin. Place on velvet cloth in cardboard box. You may layer ornaments between sheets of velvet cloth to a maximum of three layers. Cover and place in a temperature and humidity-controlled room with temperature between 63.5° and 65.8° F (77° - 56° C) and humidity between 45 and 55%.

Ornaments will require a hole for hanging on tree. Use a hand punch with a punch diameter of .1875" (4.76 mm). Protect your eyes from the paper hole that could be ejected from the punch and into your face. Wear protective eye wear!

Use string of .039" diameter (1.0 mm) to hang ornament. Ornament should not hang more than 5.23" (13.28 cm) from tree branch. Do not hang ornaments within 8" (20.32 cm) of one another. Any closer and the ornaments could tangle with the

Paper Cuts. Paper cut by scissors can cut human flesh. Cut paper edges have been known to have an edge of down to .00067" (.017018 mm), which is comparable to a razor edge! To avoid injury to your hands, wear protective gloves!

Ornaments are flammable! Do not place within 2' (60.96 cm) of open flame or within 6" (15.24 cm) of a tree light. Place 6 lb. (2.72 kg) dry chemical fire extinguisher (certified to proper charge level) within 6' (1.83 m) of tree.

These ornaments require removal from paper with scissors. Follow dotted lines carefully. Hold scissors securely between thumb and at least three fingers. Direct point of scissors away from your body. Left-handed persons should use scissors specially made for left-handed people. To find a source for left-handed scissors, go to www.shopscissors.com, but only a suggestion). You are encouraged to shop other vendors. We found performance of scissors available through shopscissors.com to be acceptable. The performance you experience may differ.

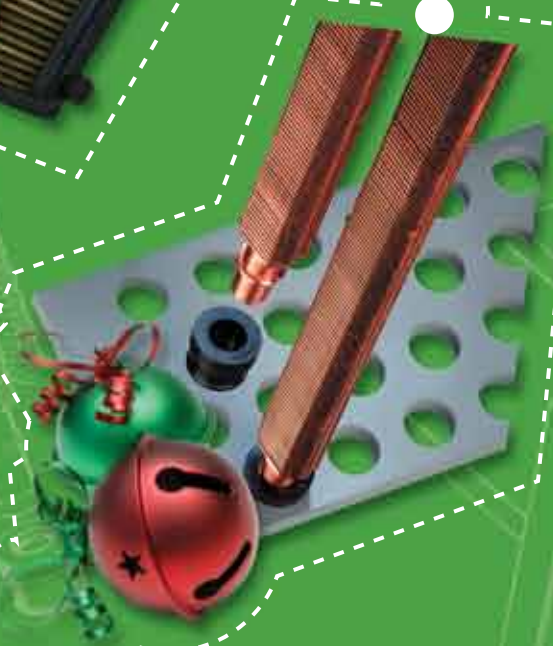
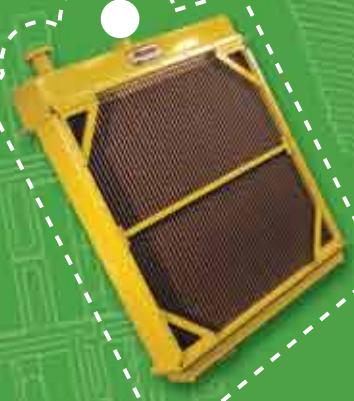
